3. Possible answers: Cheetah (African Panorama), Siberian Tiger (Asia Valley), Sumatran Tiger (Asia Valley), Clouded Leopard (Discovery Center)
4. Indian Rhino (Jordie)
5. Bats in the Kley Nocturnal room. These particular bats (Egyptian Fruit Bats) are not endangered, but many types of bats are endangered.
